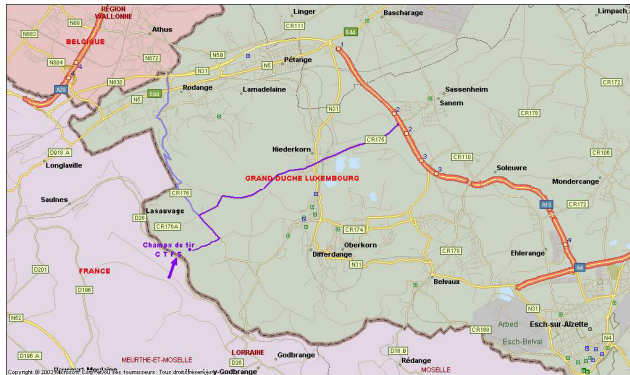

## How to find us

In order to reach the shooting range by car, please follow the A4 motorway in the direction of Esch/Alzette and take the exit „Pétange-Differdange“. Follow the A13 for approximately 10 km and take the exit „Niedercorn Differdange“ (Exit N°2). Turn left at the exit and follow the road until you reach a roundabout. Take the third exit of that roundabout (you will have a bakery to your right) and follow that road (as it will be climbing) for a couple of kilometres. You will pass three junctions (the last one leading to a car park) until you reach a cross with road signs indicating „Lasauvage“ straight ahead and „Differdange“ and „Hussigny“ to your left. Take a left turn and follow the direction of „Hussigny“ for approximately 500 meters and you see a road sign to your right indicating „CTFS DIFFERDANGE“ (see picture at the bottom of this page). Turn right at the road sign and follow that road until it ends. You have reached the shooting ground.

## 200 CLAYS TRAP COMPETITION

The competition is organised by the local clay shooting club „Club des Tireurs Fosse et Skeet“. At the event, 200 clays (eight rounds) will be presented to each shooter within two days on two Olympic trap ranges. Only ISSF authorised ammunition will be allowed (24g shells, i.e. (shot size ≤ 2.5 mm). Up to 84 shooters will be allowed to participate in the event. They will be selected according to their entry sequence.

### Training Schedule

Friday, August 27<sup>th</sup> 2010: Training from 2:00 PM until 6:00 PM  
 Cost per training round: 7.- €

### Competition programme

Saturday August 28<sup>th</sup> 2010: 8:00 AM (100 clays)  
 Sunday, August 29<sup>th</sup> 2010: 8:00 AM (100 clays + Final)  
**Last entry possibility on : Saturday August 28<sup>th</sup> 2010 at 7:45 AM!**

Cost per entry: 130.- €

### Rules

The competition will be organized according to the rules and regulations of the ISSF. The jury will be composed of experienced shooters at the beginning of the competition. Every claim must be submitted in written form along with a claim fee of 100 € which will not be reimbursed if the jury rejects the claim. The organising committee grants itself the right to change the rules and organisation if they deem necessary.

The table above will only be valid if 84 shooters attend in the event. If the number of attendants is below, the prize money will be determined according to a proportional calculation rule.

After 200 target the six best shooters will be asked to participate in the Final round. In the event of ties, the ties will be broken by shoot-offs according to the ISSF rules. If after the final there remain ties among the three best shooters, they will be broken by shoot-offs.

The assignment of a shooter to one of the categories (A, B or C) will be determined after 150 targets by excluding on of the rounds randomly. The final category ranking will be determined after 200 targets. In the event of ties between the shooters in one category the round count back rule will be used to break the ties. Exception will be made for all prize money ranks where ties will be broken by shoot-offs according to ISSF rules.

### Veteran, Women and Junior

Proportional prize money will be assigned only if at least five participants are available in each of these categories and have informed the organizing committee prior to the start of the competition that they want to be assigned to one of these categories. If no sufficient participants are available they will be ranked within one of the three standard categories according to their results.

### Dinner

The organising committee would be pleased to welcome all participants to a dinner at the shooting range on Saturday, August 28<sup>th</sup> (around 7:00 PM) in order to thank you for your venue.

### Ceremony

The ceremony will be held after the final and any potential shoot-offs on Sunday, August 29<sup>th</sup> (probably around 7:30 PM). All shooters eligible to prize money will be kindly asked to be present at the ceremony to withdraw their prize in person.
